Successes Over the Last 3 Years

- Increased Parent Involvement
 - We average 50 – 90% participation in many of our events including quarterly Family STEM Nights, quarterly Parent Report Card Day Conferences, Muffins for Moms and Donuts for Dads
- Teacher Retention
 - 100% of high performing, committed teachers retained
- STEM Implementation
 - Successful school-wide implementation in pre-k thru 3rd grade

Successes Over the Last 3 years

- Teacher Collaboration
- Professional Development – STEM pre-K thru 3rd Grade Curriculum

- Gradually Attracting Different Demographics

2013-2014			2015-2016

- Increase in Enrollment

2013-2014 = 154 students

2015-2016 = 208 students (35% increase)



Projected Timeline

2016-2017

- Developing STEM curriculum for 4th grade
- Advertise return of 4th graders during the Spring

2017-2018

- 4th graders return
- Developing STEM curriculum for 5th grade
- Advertise return of 5th graders during the Spring

2018-2019

- Return of 5th grade

This timeline allows for the 2016-2017 third grade class to remain at the school and complete fifth grade in 2018-2019.
