OUR COMMUNITY

Lake Mary, Florida, is a burgeoning suburb just north of Orlando in Seminole County and has repeatedly earned the title as one of the top five **Best Places to Live** by Money magazine. The city and the surrounding areas of Longwood, Sanford, and Winter Springs are socio-economically and racially diverse, and many of our students will be first-generation college students. Community residents are fiercely committed to their children's educations.



OUR SCHOOL

Lake Mary High School opened in 1981 as a public comprehensive high school. We offer traditional standard, honors, pre-AP, gifted, and 30 Advanced Placement courses as well as two Programs of Emphasis: the Advanced Manufacturing & Innovation Academy and Forensic Science and Legal Studies. We also offer many industry certification exams. About 55% of our seniors go straight to four-year colleges each year. In the past five years, acceptances included Vanderbilt University, Duke University, MIT, Trinity College, Princeton University, Johns Hopkins, SCAD, Stanford University, and Florida state public and private colleges and universities.

Total enrollment for the 2022-2023 school year is 2,698 students across grades 9-12, including 633 members of the Class of 2023. We had a graduation rate of 97% in 2022. Our 2022-2023 student body is approximately 52% white, 29% Hispanic/Latinx, 12% Black, and 3% Asian or Pacific Islander. Approximately 47% of the student body qualifies for free or reduced lunch. Our six counselors each advise about 460 students every year.

OUR CURRICULUM



Our students build expertise through integrated technology within a blended curriculum in which they utilize creative and critical thinking skills.

Class of 2023 Graduation Credit Requirements:

- 4 English
- 4 Mathematics (including Algebra 1 and Geometry)
- 4 Science (including Biology and 3 courses with lab components)
- 3 Social Studies (including World History, U.S. History, ½ credit U.S. Government, and ½ credit Economics)
- 1 Physical Education (including ½ credit Personal Fitness and a ½ credit P.E. elective)
- 1 Fine or Performance Art, Speech & Debate, or Practical Art
- 1 Online course (may be ½ or whole credit)
- 9 Electives

Students must pass the Grade 10 ELA portion of the Florida Standards Assessment and an End of Course exam for Algebra 1 or have a concordant/comparison score to graduate.

Students may also take classes through Florida (FLVS), Seminole County Virtual School (SCVS), or dual enroll at Seminole State College or the University of Central Florida for school credit.

Class rank is derived using students' weighted GPAs. Our highest GPA is currently 4.69.

AP & SAT DETAILS

All students enrolled in AP classes must take the corresponding exams at no cost to the student. There is no minimum grade level to be eligible for AP classes, and there is no limit to the number of AP classes students may take in a year.

- Total number of AP exams taken by LMHS students in May 2022: 1,718
- Lake Mary High School overall average pass rate (scores of 3 or higher): 55%
- Seminole County average pass rate: 61%

All students at Lake Mary High take the College Board's NMSQT version of the PSAT in 9th, 10th, and 11th grades at no cost. In addition, all 11th graders take the Spring School Day SAT, and all 12th graders take the Fall School Day SAT at no charge. 11th graders take the School Day ACT in November and March at no charge.

The Class of 2023 has 4 National Merit Semifinalists.
