What Makes Us Special

- We offer enrichment in the Arts with our Lake Orienta Theatre Company. Students in grade 3-5 can join to produce a full theatrical production of a Disney Musical.
- Additionally, we offer Makerspace which allows students to create and problem solve real world problems. Through grants and donations, we have expanded the space for grade K-5.
- Our teachers actively pursue grants to expand and add to the learning environment in their classrooms. Last year we received over \$5000 in grants to support academic achievement.

2021-2022 Data

- All students in grades K-5 participate in English and Language Arts (ELA) and Math iReady progress monitoring. **62%** of K-5 students were on or above grade level in ELA and **62%** of K-5 students were on or above grade level in Math.
- The Star Early Literacy Assessment is administered to kindergarten students at the beginning of each school year. **53%** of students demonstrated kindergarten readiness compared to the state average of 57%.

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- Technology is integrated into every classroom through computers, iPads, laptops and projectors to enhance instruction.
- Lake Orienta had an "extreme" front office make over. Adding enhanced security features to keep our students and staff safe.
- LKO's campus recently went through a beautification project. New landscaping was planted and the playground underwent a revitalization and clean up.
- LKO's Art Students had artwork on display at local area art festivals and the Orlando Museum of Art.
- LKO students are offered numerous opportunities for enrichment and challenging academics.
