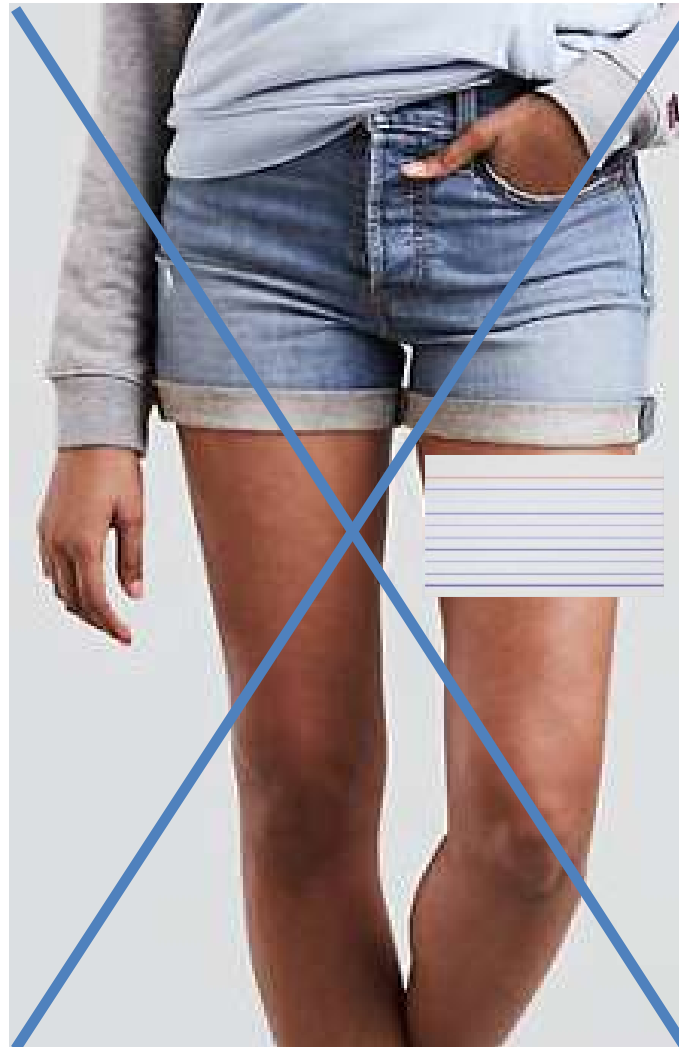
Dress Code
