The only package that is required for a student to participate in the Graduation Ceremony is the basic package for the 'Cap, Gown, and Tassel' package shown on the brochure. The fee increased to \$115 on February 1st. This base package includes your cap, gown, tassel, and all graduation related expenses (Arena Rental, Diploma, Senior Week Activities, etc.) This fee does not include the Homecoming Dance, Prom, or Grad Bash at Universal. The use of a cap and gown from another school or from a previous Lyman High School graduation will not be permitted.

If you cannot pay graduation fees all at once? Do not worry! With Herff Jones, you can make as many small payments as you would like! All graduation fees must be paid in full in order to receive your cap, gown, parking pass and tickets to the ceremony. All student debt must be paid prior to cap, gown and ticket pick up!

All cap and gown orders must be received by April 22nd.
