Message From Mr. Hunter

Over the course of the last few days, SCPS High Schools and Middle Schools have been made aware of a “Tik Tok Challenge” that is spreading on social media. This social media challenge asks for students to vandalize, steal, and break items around our school campuses. Students are videoing themselves doing these things and placing the video on social media.

Lyman High School, like many of our neighboring middle schools and high schools, has also been hit by this trend.

As you can imagine, we will not tolerate this on our campus. If a student is found to have damaged or stolen school property, they will be suspended from school, and the family will be required to pay restitution. In addition, students will be referred to law enforcement and could be charged with a criminal offense.

What can parents/guardians do to support Lyman in addressing this matter?

- Talk to your student about what vandalism is and that it is a crime and let them know it will not be tolerated.
- Report anonymously to the “See Something, Say Something” tip line at 1-800-423-TIPS
- Monitor your student’s social media accounts. Remember, many students have alternate accounts that parents are not aware of.
- If you get a video of a student vandalizing our campus, please contact the school immediately.

What can students do to support Lyman in addressing this matter?


- If you “See Something, Say Something.” Please report anything unsafe, irresponsible or illegal behavior. Report anonymously via the tip line at 1-800-423-TIPS
- Take PRIDE in our campus! This is our home, let's treat it with the respect it deserves.
- If you get a video of a student vandalizing our campus, please report it to discipline.
- Please do not like, comment on or share any illegal act on social media. Be part of the solution, not part of the problem.

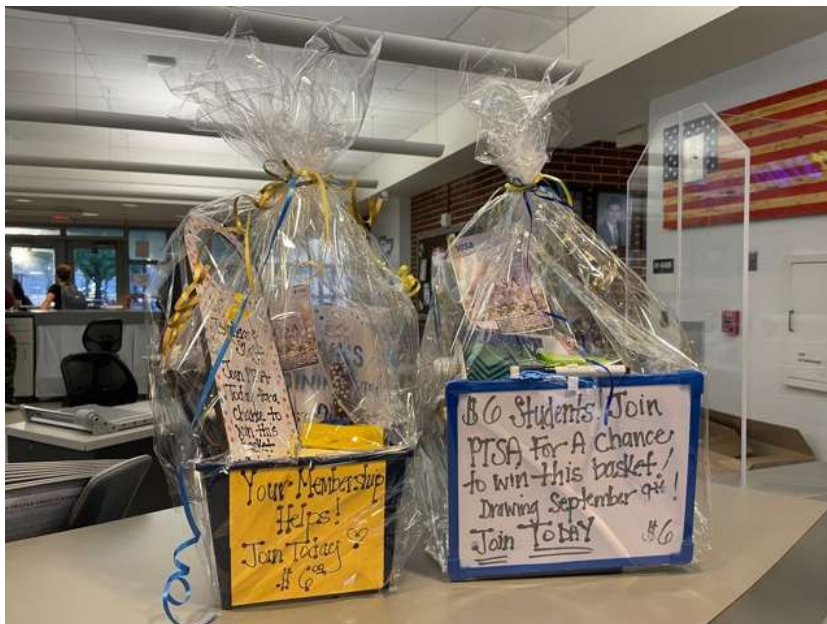

The PSAT will be given to all 9th-11th grade students on Wednesday, October 13 during the school day.

The SAT will be given to all 12th grade students on Wednesday, October 13 during the school day. Students can set up a College Board account at www.collegeboard.org and can link their account to Khan Academy where they have access to official SAT practice items.

Students will NOT need to register for these assessments and there will be no charge. More information will be sent out closer to the testing dates.
