Macon County School System set the following grading policy and retention promotion policy for this semester.

## K-12 Grading

- 3<sup>rd</sup> 9 weeks grades at 70 or above will be reported as the final grade for 2<sup>nd</sup> Semester.
- Students with grades at 70 or above for the 3<sup>rd</sup> 9 weeks will have the opportunity to earn additional points for any assignments completed during the 4<sup>th</sup> 9 weeks.
  - All extra credit work will be due May 1, 2020.
- Students with grades below 70 for the 3<sup>rd</sup> 9weeks must complete all make up assignments for the 3<sup>rd</sup> 9 weeks by:
  - o 12<sup>th</sup> grade students April 30, 2020.
  - o 11<sup>th</sup> grade and all Middle School students May 8, 2020.
  - o 9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, and K-5 students May 15, 2020.
- High School students enrolled in Dual Enrollment must complete all course work as assigned by their perspective colleges. Grades will be posted in accordance to the Dual Enrollment policy.

## **Retention/Promotion:**

K-8 Retention will be based on a yearly average consisting of 1<sup>st</sup>,2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> 9 week averages.

9-12 will be based on Carnegie Credits awarded in accordance to the promotion policy in the student handbook.
