QUALIFICATIONS: The Maria Jefferson Chapter, NSDAR, may award a scholarship to a graduating high school senior or to be sophomore or junior college student who exhibits good academic achievement and character, with preference given to those planning to major in or currently majoring in education, history, or political science. Applicant must be a resident of St Johns County.

INSTRUCTIONS: The application package must be completed and arranged in the order described below. All transcripts, letters of recommendation and other requested documents must be sent to the Chapter Scholarship Chair by the deadline of March 15, 2022. Word-processed applications are preferred. DO NOT SUBMIT A PERSONAL PHOTOGRAPH.

DOCUMENTS IN ORDER:

- 1. Scholarship Application cover page (this page).
- 2. Statement of need, 1-page maximum.
- **3.** Applicant must prepare a statement of 1,000 words or less setting forth future professional goals and reasons for these choices.
- 4. Transcript of high school or college grades to date.
- **5.** List on one side of an 8 1/2 x ll-inch paper: Extra-curricular activities, honors received, scholastic achievement and other significant accomplishments, maximum 2 pages.
- **6.** Current letters of recommendation dated and signed, from two people who are from the high school or college you now attend who are familiar with your work. The letter may cover the applicant's ability, work habits, integrity and potential.
- 7. Photocopied proof of residency in St. Johns County, FL.

REQUIRED FORMATTING AND CONDITIONS:

- **1.** Applicant package should be stapled in the top, left-hand corner.
- **2.** The applicant should be word-processing using Times New Roman or Arial font, size 12 with 1 inch margins on 8 1/2 inch paper.
- 3. Incomplete or incorrect applications WILL NOT be considered.
- **4.** Only the receiver will be notified.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

Applicants must be citizens of the United States and residents of St. Johns County, FL. They must be in high school or college. The committee will only consider fully complete applications. Incorrect or incomplete applications will be discarded. No record or supporting documents will be returned. Do NOT submit a personal photograph. The scholarship will be awarded without regard to race, religion, sex, or national origin. No affiliation with the DAR is necessary. Only the WINNER will be notified when a decision is made. Majors in History, Government, Political Science, Education will be considered first. The Chapter will choose the student and the scholarship funds will either be submitted to the college on behalf of the student or provided directly to the student to use inn payment of college fees.
