#### **Approval of Consent Agenda**

**GSBA Governance Team Achievement—Approved** to submit the Paulding County BOE for the Exemplary Board level recognition to GSBA's Board Recognition Program.

RFP 20-200110: NPHS Track Resurfacing—Approved to award Deluxe Athletics, Marietta, Georgia, to furnish all services, labor, materials and warranties to repair and re-surface the track at NPHS at the cost not to exceed \$300,000.

ITB 20-200210: Hytera Radio Equipment—Approved to award Radio One, Inc., Norcross, Georgia, to provide a means for the PCSD to purchase radio equipment and programming on an as-needed basis at the cost of \$269 (PD362i-US) or \$419 (PD362i-UI) per unit, with an initial purchase of approximately 500 units.

Completion Certificates Nebo/Panter/HJMS—Approved the completion certificates to authorize release of the last 10% of COPS reimbursement for these projects.

Maintenance Agreement with BOC—Approved the agreement with the Paulding County BOC for PCDOT to provide on-going maintenance of the traffic signal located at the intersection of North Paulding Drive and the Burnt Hickory Elementary driveway. The District will bear the cost of any single maintenance/replacement event to the extent that it equals or exceeds \$1,000 and in such event the District shall be responsible for the entirety of such cost.
