All applications must be submitted to the Scholarship Committee of John Benson Chapter NSDAR and are to be in resume form limited to no more than three (3) typewritten pages. **Attach this form to your resume and do not include your name elsewhere in the application.** Do not use unexplained abbreviations of the names of organizations in which you participate. Faculty letters of recommendation will be considered.

Students will be evaluated as follows:

1. Academic Achievement	15 points
2. Honors and Recognitions	15 points
3. Leadership (extra-curricular and community)	20 points
4. Work/volunteer experience	15 points
5. Education and Life Goals	10 points
6. Reasons for applying	20 points
7. Resume presentation	<u>5 points</u>
	100 points
