Morgan County Charter School District students and parents/guardians fully acknowledge that use of district technology on and off the premises of Morgan County Charter School District is subject to all guidelines rules and regulations as stated in the [MCHS Chromebooks: Rules, Guidelines, and Procedures](https://www.morgan.k12.ga.us/mchs/parentsstudents/parent-consent-forms) document (available online at <https://www.morgan.k12.ga.us/mchs/parentsstudents/parent-consent-forms>). **Please read this document carefully.**

At no point are students permitted to alter or mask the chromebooks network connection to the system that could change the connection between the chromebook and Morgan County Charter School District. In addition, no malicious software or websites are to be used on or with the devices. If any doubt arises with regard to an application or site please contact the Technology Department at Morgan County Charter School District.

By accepting a district owned device, parents/custodial guardians are accepting full responsibility for the replacement or repair cost of the device. This is the same procedure that is followed for textbook and calculator checkouts. Replacements and/or repairs will be exclusively managed by Morgan County Charter School District. Devices are assigned to the individual student. It is the student's responsibility to maintain control and possession of the device at all times. ANY damaged, lost or stolen devices must be reported immediately to Media Center staff, who will then report to the District Technology Department. Devices are turned in at the end of the school year. Students may be charged an administrative fee if the device is turned in late.

If at any point Morgan County Charter School District feels that the terms of this agreement have been violated, loss of privileges to use the device and other disciplinary actions may be taken. The district reserves the right to pursue all options in collection, including any necessary legal action, of costs incurred through Chromebook repair or loss.
