 - i. AAI 2020-2021 Updates

- Celebrations for student achievement: High 5 Club is students who made 5's on AP exams, CTSO achievements, and Avengers in the news
- Avengers to know and new staff members
- COVID precautions at school: social distancing in hallways and cafeteria, masks, hand washing/sanitizing reminders,
- New bell schedule- switched timing of 3rd and 4th periods; 3rd is shorter now and occurs every day, while 4th became block periods
- Options after fall break for study hall- makeups, wellness room, college and career center
- Change in car rider line for afternoons to minimize traffic on Lanier 400 Parkway
- Our first graduation will occur on May 24, 2021 at 6 pm at the Gwinnett Center (139 seniors)
- Avenger Houses and school spirit will look different this year but will still happen
- 47% are virtual for at least part of the day; Gym is being used to house FVA students during the day who are hybrid
- COVID protocol: Restart Forsyth outlines the district's plan; if student tests
 positive, contact tracing occurs 48 hours back from notification; anyone within 6
 feet for more than 15 minutes is considered direct exposure and will quarantine
 for 14 days; students will keep up with schoolwork from home through
 itslearning
- FVA courses are asynchronous and will not look exactly like a face to face class, although the content is the same
- ii. FCS Extended Online Learning Plan
 - Professional learning provided for teachers during preplanning to prep for virtual classes
 - If school closure is needed this year, synchronous teaching will occur during the
 week; best teaching practices will still be seen in all courses; teacher collaboration
 will still occur to ensure similarity in team taught courses; normal school schedule
 will still be followed; clear expectations will be provided though teacher videos
 that detail the expectations for the week; live help sessions will be offered;
 students are expected to follow all deadlines and school expectations
