Dear Beachside High School families,

The PSAT/NMSQT (Preliminary Scholastic Aptitude Test/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test) is an important upcoming assessment for all 10th grade students on **Wednesday, October 12th**. All 10th grade Beachside High School students will be automatically scheduled to take the PSAT/NMSQT, and scores will be reported at no charge.

Any 9th or 11th grade BHS student, and all 9-11th grade virtual/home education students wanting to take the PSAT/NMSQT, will need to sign up and pay a registration fee. The link is listed below, **the deadline for 9th and 11th graders to sign up and pay is Friday, September 9.**

How will students receive their scores

All students will receive their PSAT/NMSQT scores via their CollegeBoard account in December. Students will provide their email to CollegeBoard on test day via the bubble sheet. When the PSAT/NMSQT scores are uploaded online, students will get an email with instructions on creating a CollegeBoard account, going to the online score report, and using an access code to view scores.
