



 - 7TH GRADE STANDARD/ADVANCED/ ALGEBRA 1 HONORS
 - 8TH GRADE STANDARD/ADVANCED ALGEBRA 1 HONORS/GEOMETRY HONORS, PHYSICAL SCIENCE HONORS
- O ALL HIGH SCHOOL COURSES HAVE A STATE-DEVELOPED EOC WHICH IS 30% OF THEIR FINAL GRADE
- ALL 6TH GRADE STUDENTS WILL BE PLACED IN 6TH GRADE STANDARD OR 6TH ADVANCED MATH BASED ON THEIR MATH FSA SCORES, AND FINAL MATH GRADES FROM 5TH GRADE
