# What are the advanced placement options for my child?

- PVA & PIA offers a variety of options for middle grades students depending on their individualized learning path:
  - o 6th Standard/Advanced
  - o 7<sup>th</sup> grade Standard/Advanced/ Algebra 1 Honors
  - 8<sup>th</sup> grade Standard/Advance, Algebra 1 Honors/Geometry Honors, Physical Science Honors
- All High School Courses have a state developed EOC which is 30% of their final grade
- All 6<sup>th</sup> grade students will be placed in 6<sup>th</sup> grade standard or 6<sup>th</sup> advanced math based on their Math FSA scores, and final math grades from 5<sup>th</sup> grade

### Middle School Electives (1 of 2)

- Electives choices will be completed through Home Access Center (HAC).
- Choices can be entered beginning at 4:00 pm on March 1<sup>st</sup>.
- Enrollment in electives are not guaranteed, but by using this process, we will be able to open up sections based upon demand and teacher certification.
- All students are required to take the following:
  - Physical Education
  - Computers (CSD, ICT)
  - Elective of Choice
- Exceptions are made on a per student basis (i.e. band auditions, acceleration, etc).

### Middle School Electives (2 of 2)

- Our elective offerings are still a work in progress.
- Depending on enrollment, interest, and hiring the best staff, PVA is attempting to offer additional electives.
- As PIA hires staff, additional electives may be offered and will be communicated to families at a later date.

- Your student's teacher(s) are completing course recommendations now and will be available in HAC, along with your elective placement, on April 1<sup>st</sup>.
- Course changes requests will be available, digitally, between April 1<sup>st</sup>-May 31<sup>st</sup>.
