The new floors will be quieter and reduce the children's slipping and sliding.

Melissa Edwards, Worth County High School CTAE Director, reported they had been working diligently over the last year planning for their application for the Career Academy Grant funded through the Technical College System of Georgia. This grant entails a 3.2 million dollar award; with four awards given annually.

Worth County High will become the Worth County High School College and Career Academy which will be focused on preparing students in Sylvester, Worth County, and our region to enter the work force. Opportunities will be offered to students on campus as well as off campus. Our goal is to collaborate with our business partners in the community.
