2. Financial update- Mr. Laga: there were zero expenditures and zero to update to last months financial records.
3. Ted Talks:
 - A. Mr. Banton was mentioning the turkey trot for Friday and the PE Department has great representation in the event.
 - B. The School Improvement plan was sent in but awaiting feedback. PBMS addressed 4 goals for the upcoming school year: (reading, math, students with disabilities and school culture).

 - D. Survey for SJCS D American Rescue Plan. Survey is part of a grant to receive funding from the federal government. School district is looking for input.
 - E. The performing arts departments are performing at PBMS. The Drama club feature “Charlotte’s Web”, the Chorus sang the national anthem at a hockey game and the band has a concert on Friday.
 - F. PBMS had great results at the thespian competition held recently. 5 students are moving on to the regional finals.
 - G. Finally, testing for EOC’s will begin prior to the end of the quarter ion December 21st.
4. New PBIS /Students Reward System.

The system’s benefits were explained to the committee. PBMS has 1141 students that have never had a referral and we need to give recognition to these students. The software acquisition allows all of the staff to easily contribute to reward student behavior and each staff person can see track

records of all of the students at the school. The software simplifies the reward process and keeps records for all. The school store will be reopened for the new process in January.

5. Textbook adoption/math. Ms. Harding is looking for parents to volunteer in the book selection process. The process legally requires parents to be involved for transparency and assistance evaluating the textbook to be selected.
