I believe the changes associated with 1532 Middle Level Mathematics Teacher improves the opportunity to support our students (access and equity) and allows schools and districts more flexibility in scheduling qualified teachers. Allowing a teacher to receive a standard certificate for middle level math to teach Algebra 1 or Integrated Math 1 at either the middle school or high school level increases the opportunity for access and equity.
