

8th grade Rules and Routines

- Restroom Break:
 - Turn in phone when going to the restroom
 - Can go in between classes
 - Have a sign out sheet to document who is going and when
 - Students are allowed 4 per 9 weeks.
- Behavior Plan- Per Semester
 - 1st step: Warning
 - 2nd Step: Conference/Phone Call to Parent
 - 3rd Step: Time out/ Phone Call to Parent
 - 4th Step: Office Referral
- Cell Phones
 - Bag it and Tag It:
 - Take up cell phone, place in brown bag.
 - Tape up the bag real good and hand back to the student
 - Student comes back to you at the end of the day (maybe end of 4th) for you to take out of the bag
 - If student needs to use it for class they can come to the teacher but the student will have some more “Bag time” the next day
- Hallway- NO food, drinks and cell phones allowed

7th grade Rules and Routines

Restroom passes

- Each student will be allowed six restroom passes per semester in addition to going in between classes.
- Students can go to the restroom beyond that as needed in exchange for five Titan bucks/stamps or a day of silent lunch.
- Students will be required to put their cell phone in bin in classroom before receiving a restroom pass.

Behavior plan steps

- There will be a five step plan of consequences for negative behavior.
 - 1st step--student conference
 - 2nd step--phone call to parent
 - 3rd and 4th steps--time out/in-team/detention, which depends on circumstances. These will be accompanied by phone call home by two or more of that student's teachers.
 - 5th step--referral
- Of course, consequences for positive behavior are also in place including but not limited to Titan bucks/stamps, patio passes, Student of the Week, etc . . .

Cell phones

- Phones will be permitted to be used only with teacher approval. Students will receive one warning which will accompany a parent contact. Following incidents will result in a referral. This will be tracked in a Microsoft or Canvas group live document.

6th Grade Rules and Routines

- Restroom Break:
 - Student have 9 bathroom passes per class per nine weeks.
 - Students must sign out on their behavior card
 - Students should not go to the restroom between classes.
 - Students may use restroom during homeroom with a pass and on the way back from lunch.
- Behavior Plan-
 - 1st step: Student teacher conference
 - 2nd Step: Phone Call to Parent
 - 3rd Step: Teacher Determined consequence (silent lunch, writing reflection, after-school detention) and parent contact
 - 4th Step: Time Out
 - 5th Step: Office Referral

Classroom Behavior Cards will be used to track student behavior.

- Cell Phones

No use of cell phones/technology unless directed by the teacher. If students are caught with their phones, including hallway and homeroom they will:

1. Be warned about unauthorized technology use (parent contact)
2. Moved up one step on the Student Behavior Plan (parent contact)

- Lockers

- Locker breaks during homeroom, 3rd and 5th period. (possibly after 6th before dismissal)
