Who is eligible?

Current 8. or 9. Grader Enrolled in Algebra 1 or higher

- 6. and 7. grade ELA FSA 3 or above
 6. and 7. grade Math FSA <u>or</u> Algebra 1
 EOC 3 or above
- 8 and 9 grade 1 Qtr. Report Card-No D or F

HS cumulative unweighted GPA 3.0 or higher



Students in the CHSP will earn both a standard high school diploma as well as an Associate of Arts (AA) Degree upon the completion of four years of high school if they complete all CHSP requirements.

How do I apply?

Process

- Letters will be sent to qualifying 8 and 9 graders inviting them to the SJRSC Collegiate High School Orientation via the district School Messenger
- Interested students and parent/guardian must attend a SJR State information session prior to applying through the Program of Choice Application Process -1/8/21
- Students will be notified after the lottery. Those accepted will be required to submit the college admission packet prior to Dual Enrollment course registration.

- Complete online application through <u>student's</u> Home Access Center (HAC).
 - Opens January 8, 2021
 - Closes February 5, 2021 @ 5:00 pm
- If applying for IB or AICE, request a completed Teacher Recommendation form from your four core content area teachers.
- If applying for St Johns County Center for the Arts at St Augustine High School, apply and audition by January 29, 2021.
