Application Process

- Complete online application through <u>student's</u> Home Access Center (HAC).
 - Opens January 8, 2021
 - Closes February 5, 2021 @ 5:00 pm
- If applying for IB or AICE, request a completed Teacher Recommendation form from your four core content area teachers.
- If applying for SJCCA, apply and audition by January 29, 2021.
- Students can apply for up to 3 Programs of Choice, but must rank them as their 1, 2, and 3 choices.
 - It IS possible to be accepted to two programs at the same school, but you won't be accepted to two programs at two different schools via the lottery



Application Process

FINAL NOTES:

- If students attend a school other than their zoned school, they must provide their own transportation.
- If your zoned school offers an ROTC program or IB/AICE, you cannot apply to an ROTC or IB/AICE program at another school. You must apply to the program offered at your zoned school.
