#### EFFECTS OF ACUTE EXPOSURE

**EYES:** Causes severe eye irritation. Symptoms may include pain, tearing, redness, and clouding of the eye surface.

**SKIN:** May cause skin irritation. Symptoms may include redness, rash and mild swelling.

**INHALATION:** High concentrations of vapor or mist may cause nose, throat and respiratory tract irritation. Symptoms may include coughing and a burning sensation in the nose and throat.

**INGESTION:** May cause mouth, throat and stomach irritation. Symptoms may include nausea, vomiting and diarrhea.

**EFFECTS OF CHRONIC EXPOSURE:** Prolonged or repeated contact can cause defatting and drying of the skin which may result in skin irritation and dermatitis (rash).

**MEDICAL CONDITIONS AGGRAVATED:** May aggravate pre-existing eye, skin and respiratory conditions.

## 4. FIRST AID MEASURES

**EYES:** Immediately flush eyes with plenty of water while holding eyelids apart. After initial flushing, remove any contact lenses and continue flushing for at least 15 minutes. Do not put any medication in the victim's eyes unless instructed by a physician. Get immediate medical attention.

**SKIN:** Flush thoroughly with plenty of water, then wash with soap and water. Remove saturated clothing. Get medical attention if irritation develops or persists. Thoroughly wash (or discard) clothing and shoes before reuse.

**INHALATION:** Remove to fresh air. If not breathing, give respiration; if breathing is difficult, give oxygen (by trained personnel only). Get medical attention if symptoms persist.

**INGESTION:** Do not induce vomiting. Drink large quantities of water. Get immediate medical attention. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

**STORAGE:** Keep container closed when not in use. Store away from incompatible materials. (See Section 10, Stability and Reactivity).


