JROTC HEADS TO NATIONAL LEADERSHIP BOWL!

The Leilehua High School JROTC team is off to compete in the National Leadership Bowl Championship in Washington, DC.

After advancing through two phases of online competition, the Leilehua High School "Mighty Mules" JROTC Leadership Team composed of Cadets Jordan Banner, Zamarie Familia, Maliza Lincoln, and team alternate Logan Delp will compete in person at the Championship event in Washington, DC. The 2023 Army JROTC Leadership Bowl Championship will be held on the campus of The Catholic University of America, June 18-22, 2023. This event is sponsored by the Army JROTC and is conducted by College Options Foundation.

The Leilehua High School JROTC team earned top scores out of approximately 1,378 Army JROTC teams that competed from around the world. The team is one of only forty Army JROTC Leadership Bowl teams in the nation to advance to the National Leadership Bowl competition, which includes an all-expense paid trip to the Championship event in DC. During the two fast-paced preliminary rounds, cadets were tested on their knowledge of current events, leadership values, and leadership skills. This is the 3rd National Leadership Championship appearance in 6 years for the Leilehua HS JROTC Battalion teams.

The JROTC Leadership & Academic Bowl (JLAB) is a nationally recognized competition created exclusively for JROTC students. By participating, cadets learn the values of citizenship, academic competition, and college opportunity. The competition creates tremendous opportunities for JROTC cadets by allowing them to demonstrate leadership and academic abilities.




