

WHAT IS THE FAFSA?

Completing it is one of the most important steps to making college affordable. The FAFSA is the application that is required to be used by all schools in awarding federal student aid. If you want federal loans, federal grants, or federal work-study, you have to do the FAFSA!

WHAT DO I NEED TO COMPLETE THE FAFSA?

- Social Security Number
- Alien Registration Number (Only for non-U.S. citizens)
- Most recent federal income tax returns, W-2s, and other records of money earned. (Note: You may be able to transfer your federal tax return information into your FAFSA using the IRS Data Retrieval Tool.)
- Bank statements and records of investments (if applicable)
- Records of untaxed income (if applicable)
- · FSA ID to sign the FAFSA electronically.
 - Go to https://studentaid.ed.gov/sa/fafsa/fillingout/fsaid (Apply for your FSA ID ahead of time because it takes 1 to 3 days for the Social Security Administration to verify your information. If you cannot do it ahead of time then you can still do the FAFSA up to the signature page at least at the workshop.)
- If you are a dependent student, then you will also need most of the above information for your parent(s).
