Johann Pachelbel – 1653 -1706

- German composer, organist, and teacher
- an important composer of the Baroque Era (the same time as Handel and Bach)
- Pachelbel is best known for the Canon in D, as well as the Chaconne in F minor, the Toccata in E minor for organ
- Pachelbel experimented with different combinations of instruments and singers in his compositions
