



## DRESS CODE REMINDERS

- READ SAHS STUDENT PLANNER
- LADIES

  - LOSS OF DRIVER'S LICENSE




### **LOCKERS**



- Students may remove their mask in class when given permission and at lunch while eating




### **At SAHS A Face Mask Must:**
