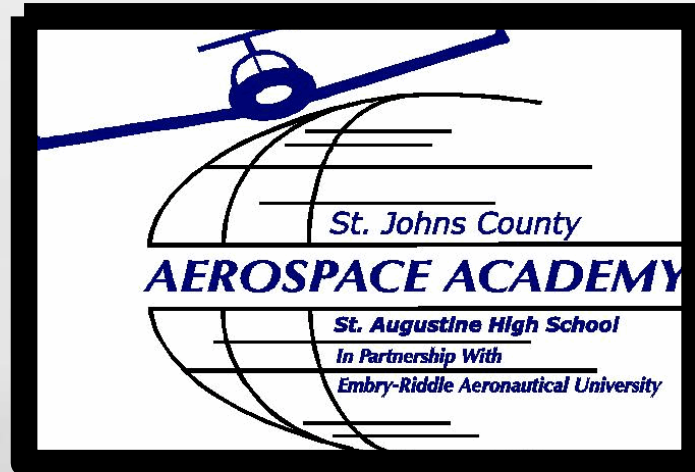

SAHS HEADPHONE POLICY

Students may use headphones, earbuds, AirPods, etc.:

If misused, will be confiscated



DRESS CODE REMINDERS

- **READ SAHS STUDENT PLANNER**

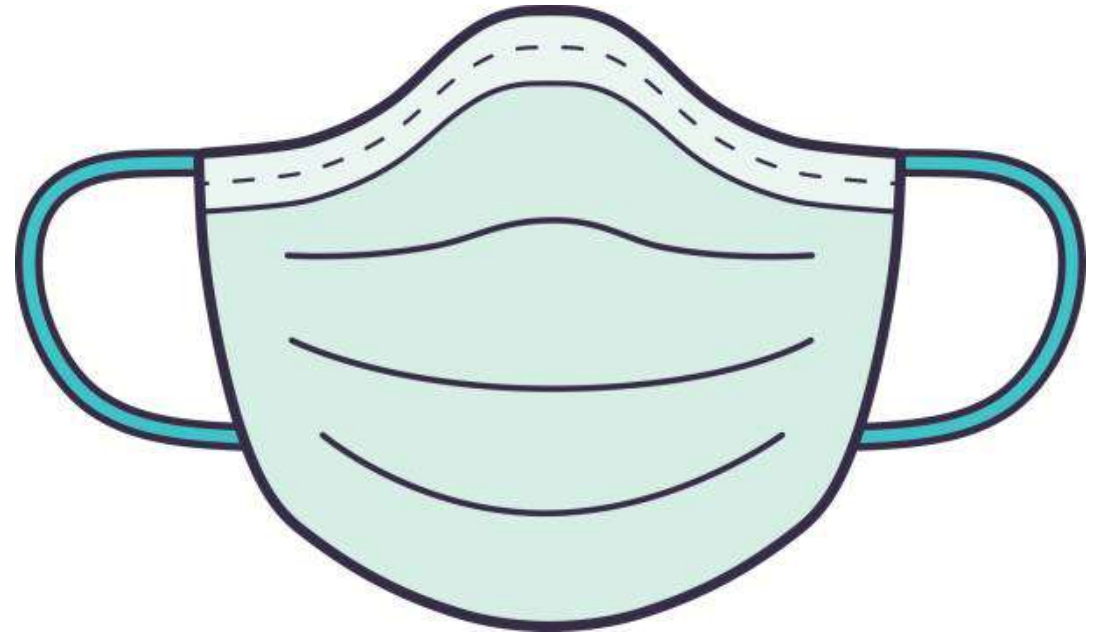
STUDENT ID CARDS AND LANYARDS
