For safety reasons, there should be *no parking on the street* between the two schools to drop off students in the morning. We have been told about several "close calls" from the Lakeside Staff.


Please do not park or stop your car at the gate entrance to drop off your child/children. Thank you so much for your help in keeping all of our students safe!



~ Summer Ideas



Flashcards: Addition and Subtraction. You can get these at a dollar store. Multiplication, Alphabet, and more flashcards are a great tool to review materials taught during the school year.

- Time: Practice telling time....a lot! Look at the clock/watch when....
 - Your child watches his/her favorite TV show.
 - When (s)he eats. --When (s)he finishes eating.
- When (s)he goes out to play –When (s)he comes back from playing.
- Discuss how long something took.



Money: In a bowl have real money and play "store" at home. Sell him/her snacks. (S)he would have to pay for whatever (s)he wants and (s)he will have fun while learning/reviewing to count money...and give Change back!
