## UNIFORM DRESS CODE EARLY DISMISSAL DAYS

Mundy's Mill Middle School Early Dismissal Days. The Early Dismissal 2016-2017 school year will continue to promote a safe learning environment, students are to wear the following: **solid color shirts, black, red, gray (8<sup>th</sup> grade only), or white with khaki or black bottoms (pants, shorts, or skirts).** Belts are a required part of dress code requirements. The following will not be permitted: **pull over hoodies, cut off/frayed, or tight shorts; skinny style, tight, jeans, or stretch pants, for female students, shorts or skirts must not be shorter than 3 inches above the bend of the knee.** In addition, pull-over garments (vests, sweaters, or light weight jackets) must be solid white, gray, red or black. ## SCHOOL HOURS

**The middle school day will be from 8:10 am until 3:10 pm. Students should not arrive at school prior to the school building opening at 7:30 am.** Students must be in their homeroom by 8:10 am. If they arrive later than 8:10 am, they must check-in at the front office.

## BEFORE SCHOOL PROGRAM

A supervised before school program is offered to students that need to arrive at school before 7:30 am. Hours are from 6:30 am – 7:30 am.

## AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAM

Many parents have inquired as to an afterschool care program for our middle school. We would like to know how many of our students are in need and would actually participate in an afterschool care program. **If offered, parents would have to provide transportation and pay a fee for student participating in the afterschool care program.** If we have enough interest, the details of such a program will be provided as soon as possible.

## COURSE OFFERINGS

Our school offers a wide range of academic and connection courses for students to enjoy. Academic classes are language arts, mathematics, science, and social studies. Students may elect to take a performance class of chorus, band, or orchestra. Web design is offered to our 8<sup>th</sup> grade students. Both the performance and web design courses are yearlong connections courses. Semester long connections offerings are business and computer science, art, and physical education. Reading connections are also offered during connections classes. Health is offered to 8<sup>th</sup> grade as a semester long class.

## SPORTS AT THE MILL

Sports teams at the Mill include football, volleyball, basketball, swimming and track. Each sport, whether boys or girls, will have one eighth grade team. Sixth and seventh grade students that meet eligibility may also try out. **Students wishing to try out for interscholastic middle school sports may do so if they have passed five out of six classes for the previous semester and meet state**
