

RENAISSANCE PROGRAM

NOTICE FOR STUDENTS AND PARENTS

The Renaissance program rewards students who have earned a GPA of 3.5 or higher, on a quarterly basis, at Samuel E. Kalama Intermediate School.

In addition to high academics, students are expected to meet a minimum number of community service hours. Rewards include field trips, leave class early, treats, peer recognition, etc. Any deficiencies(behavior referrals, outstanding library obligations) or any class D/F disqualifies the student for that quarter.

There is an annual banquet for Renaissance students who have achieved an cumulative average of 3.5 for quarters, 1,2 and 3 and who have also completed their community service hours.

Students who have not completed their service hours by next week Wednesday, February 7th, <u>will not</u> be able to receive the rewards card, or treat for the quarter, nor qualify for the recognition assembly.

Students can still go on their field trip, provided they meet the minimum community service requirement, <u>before</u> the field trip form's deadline.

Students who have not completed hours but that the grades, will receive a certificate for their academic work, but not a Renaissance certificate.

All students who have a 3.50 or better GPA will be published in the Maui News, pending their A/V form being turned in.


