Graduation Requirements

- ONE DIPLOMA TYPE: No more College Prep and Tech Prep differentiation.
- •23 credits to graduate
- •All students beginning 9_{th} grade in 2015 will have the following graduation requirements:

23 Credits to Graduate

- English = 4 credits
- Math = 4 credits
- Science = 4 credits
- Social Studies = 3 credits
- CTAE &/or ModernLanguage &/or Fine Arts=3 credits
- Career, Technical and Agricultural Education (CTAE)

- Health <u>and</u> Personal Fitness (Not Weight Training) =1 credit
- Or 3 JROTC classes = Health and Personal Fitness credit

Remaining credits are elective credits

Don't worryyou have 4 years...

9th graders are required to take:

- English Ninth Grade Lit. & Composition or Honors Ninth Grade Lit. & Composition
 - placement based on 6th and 7th grade CRCT English scores
 - performance and 8_{th} grade teacher recommendation
- Science Biology or Honors Biology
 - placement is based on 7_{th} grade CRCT science scores
 - performance and 8_{th} grade teacher recommendation
- •Math Coodinate Algebra, Accel Coordinate Algebra/ Analytic Geometry A, or Accel Math 2
 - placement is based on 7_{th} grade CRCT math scores
 - performance and 8_{th} grade teacher recommendations
- Personal Fitness and Health

More Options....

- •Foreign Language (Spanish, French or German, and Russian). Two years or credits of the same foreign language are recommended for students interested in college.
- •CTAE classes listed on the elective handout for 9_{th} graders. Please get involved with a career pathway, it is a great way to get some experience and gain some useful skills.
- •Driver's Ed., which costs \$100, is a semester long class that is also offered to freshmen.
- Payment is due by March 6, 2015.

Advanced Placement

- Mainly 11th and 12th grade courses -Math, Science, English, Social Studies, Foreign Language, Art
- 9th grade AP Human Geography

Know what you are taking!

- When you sign up for an elective class, be sure that is what you want to take. Consider your interests, your abilities and your goals.
- The master schedule is built based on student requests. Your elective requests are considered as your first choices. You may be placed in one of your 'alternate choices,' if necessary.
- Since all freshmen will be in Personal Fitness during the school year, coaches will make recommendations for 9_{th} grade weight training.
- Driver's Ed requires a \$100 fee. In order to have Dr Ed on your 9th grade schedule, the \$100 fee is due to Sandra Sutton, NFHS secretary by March 6, 2015.




