It is a national organization which was founded in 1921 by the National Association of Secondary School Principals for the purposes of honoring students who excel in the areas of scholarship, character, leadership, and service.



Besides scholarship, what are the other criteria for membership?

LEADERSHIP

The National Honor Society requires members to demonstrate leadership in and outside of school. These should be listed on your application.

SERVICE

Juniors: A minimum of 40 hours must be documented in HAC by August 11th

Seniors: A minimum of 50 hours must be documented in HAC by August 11th

CHARACTER

Applicants must be a student of good character, uphold principles of morality and ethics.

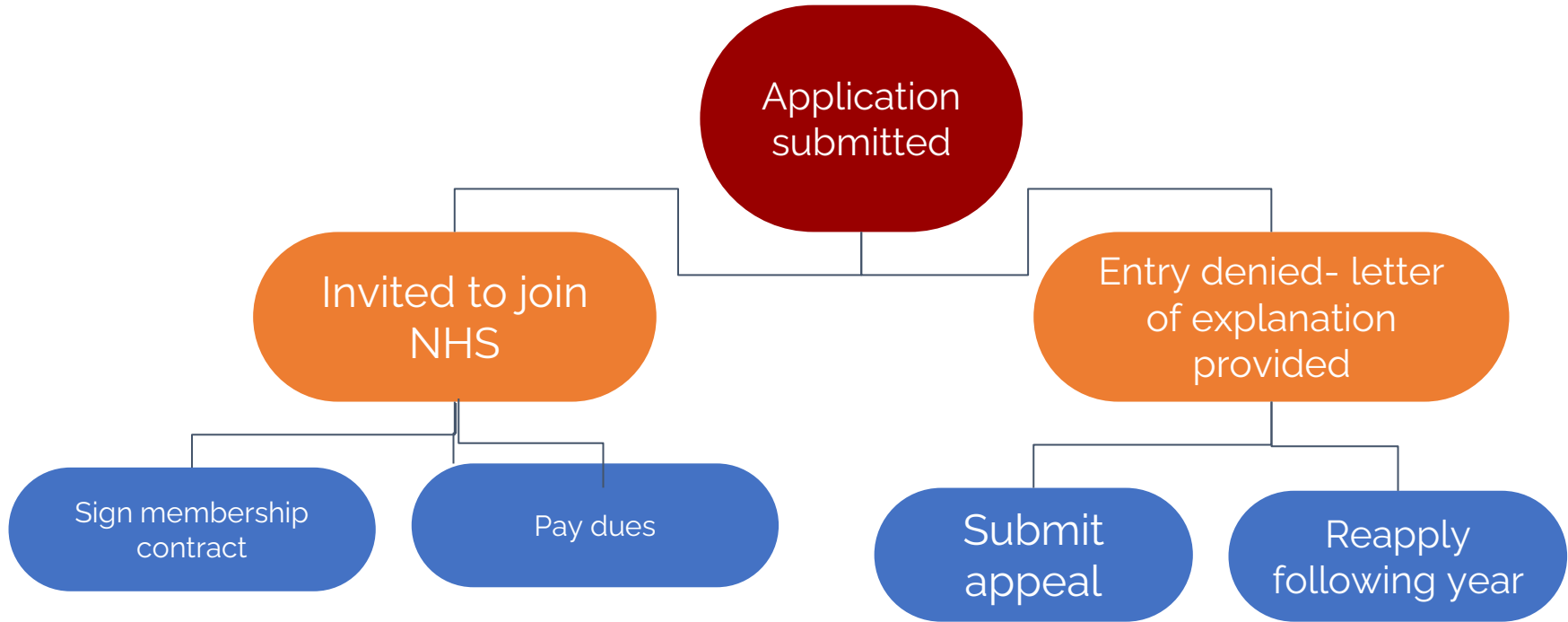

Selection Process

- ❑ The Faculty Council, comprised of six staff members, will consider all applicants that meet minimum GPA and service hour criteria.
- ❑ Membership selection will be based on completed application, verification of service hours, and verification of GPA.



The Selection Process



Rights:

- Receive recognition from the school and community as a lifetime member of NHS
- Display the NHS insignia
- To be considered for all NHS scholarships, awards, etc.
- To have a fair hearing by the Faculty Council before your membership can be revoked

Responsibilities:

As a member of the National Honor Society, you must:

- Maintain a 3.75 cumulative GPA
- Enroll in a minimum of 2 honors (or higher) level courses
- Uphold the NHS Keystones
- Complete a minimum of 25 hours of service a year
- Assist in tutoring (a minimum of 2 hours per semester)
- Participate in quarterly service projects
- Participate in fundraising
- Attend monthly meetings- Meetings will be held once a month for approximately 30 minutes. CURRENTLY MEETINGS ARE ON WEDNESDAY AM
- To pay annual dues of \$20 (NEW MEMBERS)
