- I will maintain or exceed the required GPA each semester. If I do not, I will be placed on probation for the following semester. If I do not increase my GPA to a 3.2 after the probationary semester, I will be dismissed from NHS. If I am a senior, and I do not meet my GPA requirements for the spring semester, I understand that there will be no probationary semester and I will not receive an honor cord at graduation.
- I will participate in at least 2 service projects for the fall semester and 2 service projects in the spring semester for a total of 4 service projects for the year. If I fail to complete the required number of service projects for any semester, I understand that I will be placed on probation for the following semester. If I fail to complete my service requirements after the probationary period has ended, I will be dismissed from NHS. If I am a senior, and I do not meet my service project requirements for the spring, I understand that there will be no probationary semester and I will not receive an honor cord at graduation.
- I will behave in an honorable, scholarly manner that gives evidence to my character and leadership.
- I will attend at least three-fourths of all general meetings of the WSHS chapter of the NHS. (Meetings are the 4th Thursday of each month in the auditorium.) When I miss a meeting, I must check in with the chapter advisor or officers to find out what was missed. I must listen to the BearTV morning announcements to find out about events. I can sign up for text reminders/alerts and follow the NHS website located on the Winter Springs homepage -> students -> organizations-> NHS.
- Dues are \$10 for underclassmen and \$17 for seniors. Dues are non-refundable.

I understand that if I do not uphold the designated statutes and it is determined that I have failed to remain a member in good standing that I will lose my membership and cannot rejoin the WSHS chapter. Seniors who are dismissed will not receive an honor cord at graduation.
