<u>FYI – Before You Commit</u>

- Membership in the Landrum Middle School Chapter is open to <u>8th graders only</u>. <u>Students should apply at the end of their 7th grade year to participate during their 8th grade year.</u>
- Students must maintain a minimum of a 3.5 GPA to be accepted.
- NJHS meets the second Tuesday of each month after school until around 2:45 unless otherwise noted. Members are expected to make every effort to attend all meetings and participate in all NJHS activities.
- Students selected for membership will receive a CONTRACT and BY-LAWS to sign and return, finalizing their acceptance.
 - a. Please be aware that there is a \$20 membership fee for NJHS. This helps pay for our national accreditation, a membership t-shirt, and any start-up materials for activities. Any additional money left over in the budget at the end of the year is donated to a charity selected by the members of Landrum's NJHS. *This note is simply to make you aware, but please do not pay this now!* A link will be made available on SchoolPay once acceptance letters go out.
 - b. NJHS members are also required to complete at least 20 service hours by May of their 8th grade year. The hours must be collected after May 2022 and before May of 2023. Hours collected before May 2022 will not be counted towards the 20 required hours.

 - Applicants must have a minimum GPA of 3.5 to be accepted.
- □ Completed Service, Leadership, Character, and Citizenship sections in the application.
- □ Four teacher recommendation names/subject areas
- □ Applicant signature

SCHOLARSHIP:
