The activity for the month of **October** is "**Family Art Museum.**" Spend some quality time with your children creating a family art display. Help your child choose a few favorite pictures from a trip, grab a few items sitting around in the house, or take some pictures of pets or things in the yard. Join your children in drawing and coloring or painting a picture of the items gathered or items in the photographs. Set up an art display and tie in some math or writing activities, such as describing shapes in the pictures or have your children write a description of their artwork. To challenge your child, you can assist them in taking pictures of various architecture on an outing, such as a trip to a downtown area, where they can photograph tops of building, door, windows, etc. to paint or draw. Be creative in your family art display adventure. You can tie in technology by assisting your children in searching for online children's art museums or helping them use a program, such as Microsoft Word, where they can use shapes to create a picture.
