How do students pay for items purchased at the Book Fair?

- **Cash:** Students will be given a receipt, along with any change from the purchase.
- **Checks:** made payable to "JCE". We are unable to provide cash change for checks so if you send your child with a pre-written check of \$15, we will help them get as close to that amount as possible and then the rest would be a donation to the school book fair. Ex: \$15 check and the total is \$13.12, then \$1.88 is donated. You're welcome to send in a blank check payable to JCE and we'll fill in the exact amount for your child. Please let us know with a sticky or an email the amount you don't want your child to exceed.
- **E-Wallet:** Log onto the book fair link and you can load an e-wallet for your child. More information is available at the Book Fair link above.

What happens if I forget to send money for my student on their assigned day?

Students will be able to purchase items at parent night, or last minute shoppers can visit the Book Fair on Friday, October 15 from 8:00-9:30am or 12:30-2:00pm.
