Advanced Placement Test Performance

2021-2022 Data



Oviedo High School administered 1568 Advanced Placement exams in 31 courses (**at no cost** to students). The most popular AP courses are English Language and Composition, Human Geography, US Government and Politics, World History, and Environmental Science.

OHS had an average **pass rate of 72%** on AP exams. For comparison, the Florida pass rate was 51%, and the national pass rate was 57%.

SAT Scores

All juniors and seniors at OHS get an opportunity to take the SAT **at no cost**.

The average Oviedo High School SAT score is **1065** out of 1600, higher than the Florida average of 983.

OHS students in 9-11th grade have an opportunity to take the PSAT **at no cost**.

OHS 10th graders had an average PSAT score of **974** out of 1520, higher than the Florida average of 890.

College Acceleration and Workforce Readiness

63% of OHS students take some form of acceleration (college-level classes or industry certifications).

OHS also offers **16 industry certifications**. Some of the most popular ones are Certified Food Safety Manager and ASE Entry-level - Auto: Brakes (BR). In total, students earned **671 industry certifications**.

- OHS had a total enrollment of 2,200 students across grades 9-12 in 2022-2023.
- OHS offers CTE programs such as Biotechnology, Culinary Arts, Automotive Repair, Interior Design, Early Childhood Ed, and TV Production.
- In 2020, 28% of OHS seniors qualified for Bright Futures and earned over \$7 million in scholarships.
- OHS was ranked a top high school by US News & World Report and the Washington Post.
- OHS offers 29 Advanced Placement (AP) classes and boasts an AP exam pass rate far exceeding state, national, and global averages.
- Clubs offered include SGA, BETA, SECME, Mu Alpha Theta, Quill and Scroll, Debate, National Honor Society, FCA, Robotics, and Best Buddies.
- OHS has numerous athletic teams, including a state boys swim team and individual state champions in several sports. Within the last few years, OHS has been named the FACA Athletic Program of the Year and Floyd E. Lay Sunshine Cup All-Sports Awards Program.
