- Color Tiles

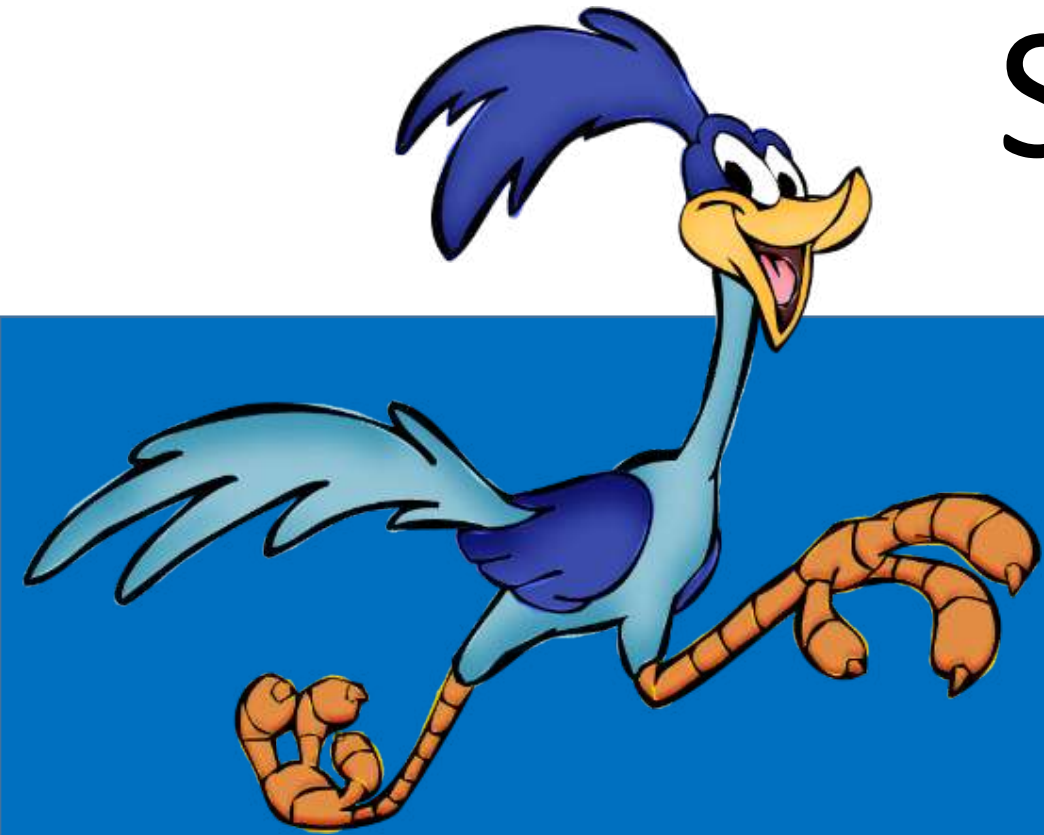
Assignments pt.1
