# 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade Expectations



- Huge difference between 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> grade
  - **More responsibility**
    - Writing homework and spelling words down weekly
    - Returning items – teacher will not check binders
    - Study guides
  - **More Independent**
    - Working independently
    - Being prepared for all tests
  - **Georgia Milestones in April (Math and ELA)**

# Grading System for 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade



- 4=Exceeding
- 3=Mastery
- 2=Progressing
- 1= Needs Improvement

\* Scores of 1 and 2 are considered failing.

# Progress Reports and Report Cards



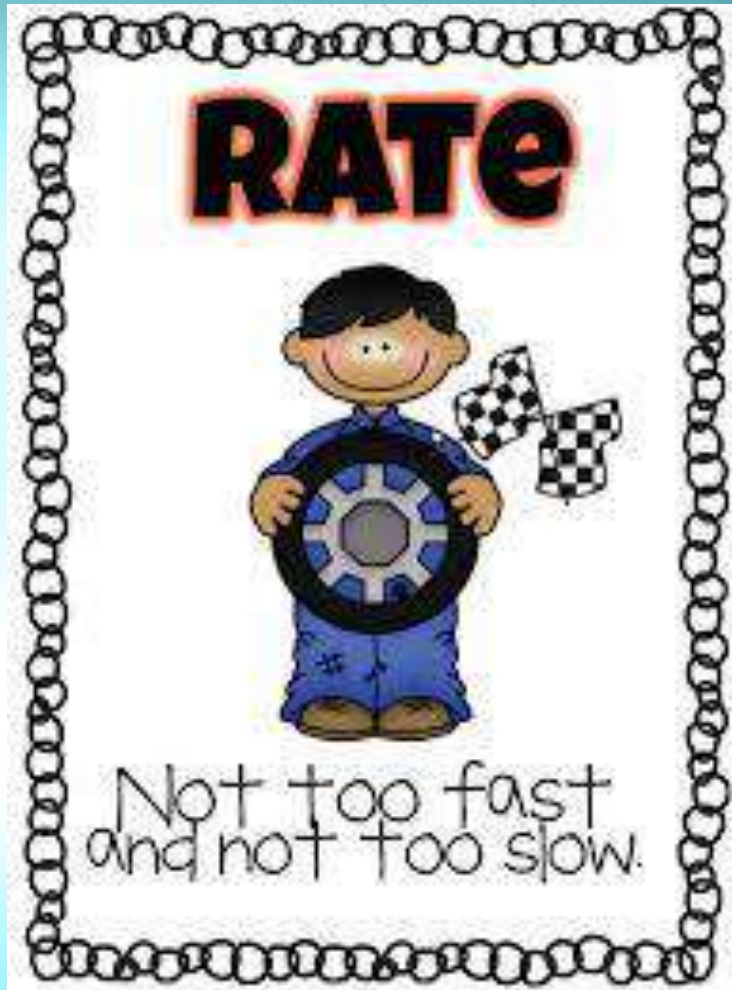
- Progress Reports are every 4 ½ weeks and show the standards we have been working on.
- Report Cards are every 9 weeks and show the standards we cover over that 9 week period.
- Parent conferences are the weeks of Oct. 10-14 and March 20-24. I will use Sign Up Genius for you to pick the best available time.



# Fluency

Fluency is assessed weekly. Your child needs to read 120 words per minute by the end of Third Grade.

After mastering this standard, your child will continue to be monitored but will not have fluency homework.



# Math Fact Fluency



- 3<sup>rd</sup> graders should already have addition and subtraction facts memorized.
- **Multiplication facts are the focus for 3<sup>rd</sup> grade.**
- Knowing these facts is extremely important to your child's success.
- Ideas to help:
  - Make flash cards with index cards
  - Buy flash cards
  - Play a game with your child to see if they can produce the answer before you can retrieve the answer on a calculator (Beat the Calculator)
  - Internet games ([www.multiplication.com](http://www.multiplication.com))

  - Sign and return folder, keep papers

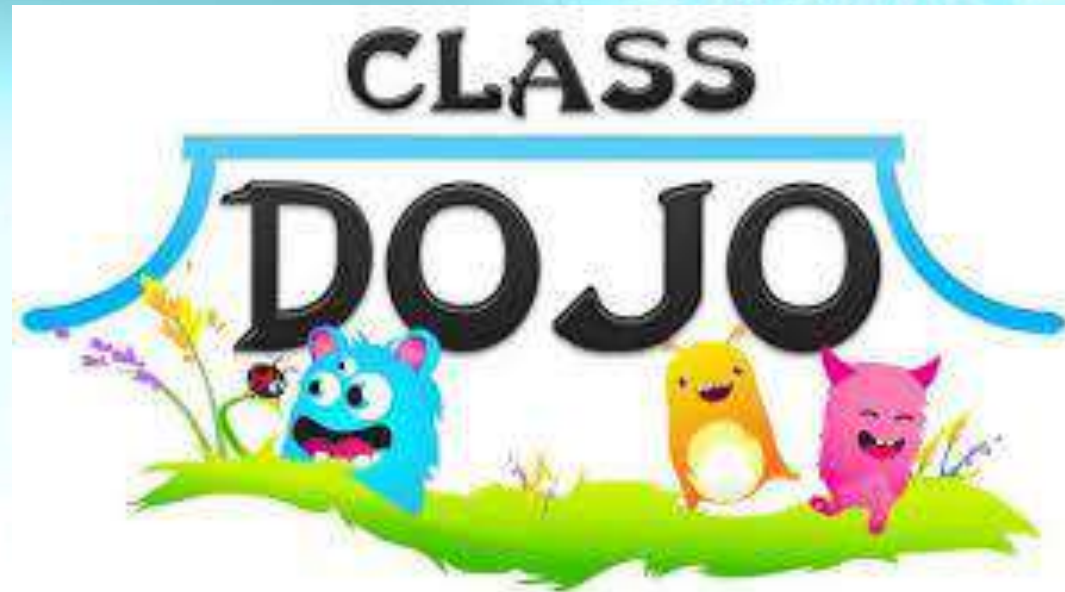
# Behavior and Class Dojo
