

ACTION ITEM – Current 6th Graders!!

The Florida Department of Health and the Department of Education require all students entering 7th grade to have a Tdap booster (adult strength tetanus, diphtheria, and pertussis) vaccine.

This vaccine can be obtained from your child's health care provider. Required vaccines are also available at the Florida Department of Health in Seminole County for students with Medicaid, without insurance or insurance does not cover vaccines, or who are unable to obtain them through a private provider. Appointments are required. Please call 407-665-3700 to schedule. An updated Florida Certification of Immunization DH 680 Form must be presented to your child's school before your child can receive a schedule or enter school on the first day of classes, August 10, 2022.

Incomplete forms, immunization histories, billing receipts and notes from doctor's offices will not be accepted. Forms should be turned in as soon as possible. Any questions please call 407-871-7006.

Quarantine & COVID Policy Updates

If your child tests positive for COVID during school hours, please call the main office at 407-871-7050. If after hours, please email Dr. Laudani at <u>Melissa_Laudani@scps.k12.fl.us</u> Please tell us when and where the test was taken (if at home, was it reported via the app or website), what are your child's symptoms and when did they start. Once we have that information, we will provide you with a return date. We will notify their teachers.

If your child is exposed to someone with COVID on campus, you will receive a COVID Notification Letter. This is just to inform you of the exposure. If you choose to quarantine your child, you need to notify the school via the Attendance Email at <u>LCMS Attendance@scps.k12.fl.us</u> You will also need to notify your child's teachers if they will be missing school as you would with any other absence.
