




## WHAT IS A YEAR-LONG ELECTIVE?

\*No student will be turned away for financial reasons.




## 6<sup>TH</sup> GRADE YEAR-LONG ELECTIVES BY APPLICATION

- Enrollment in a theatre class is not necessary to audition or participate in after-school performances.










### SJMSAA (St. John's Middle School Athletic Association):
