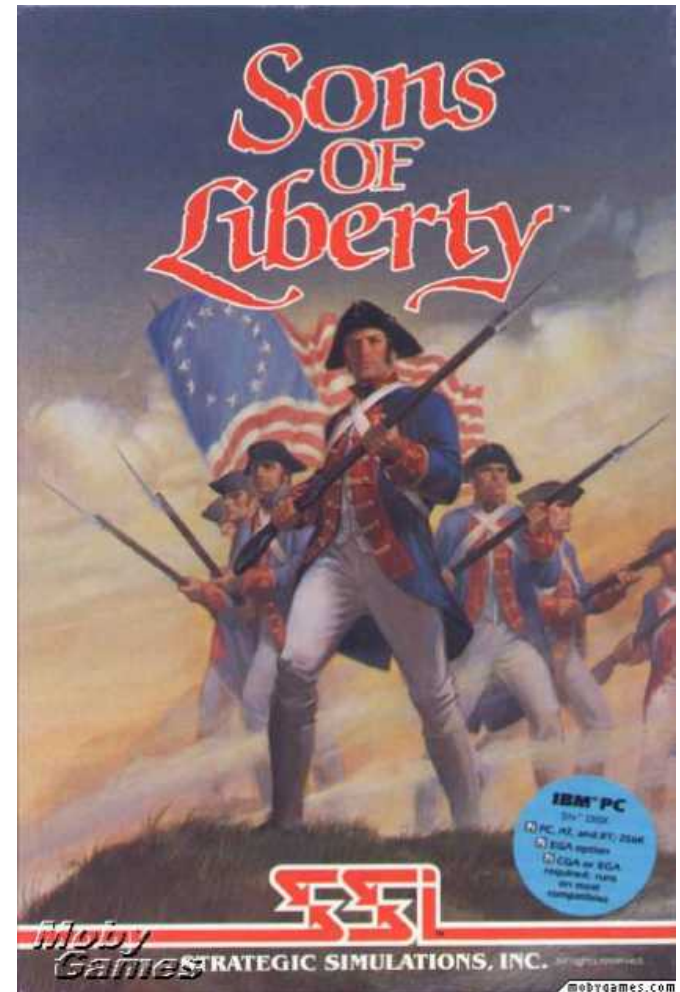

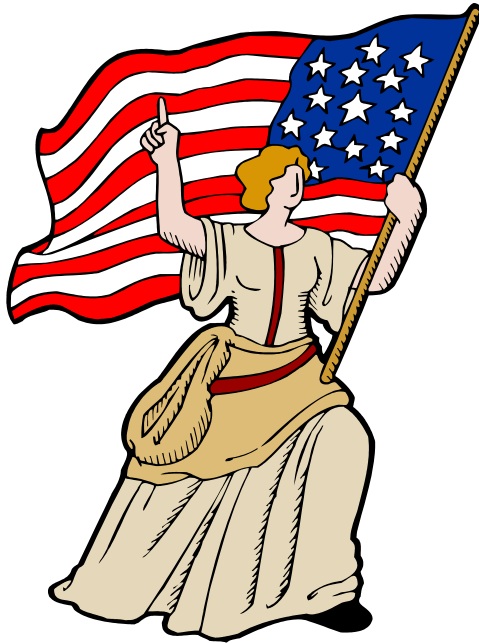


What did the members of the Sons of Liberty have in common?

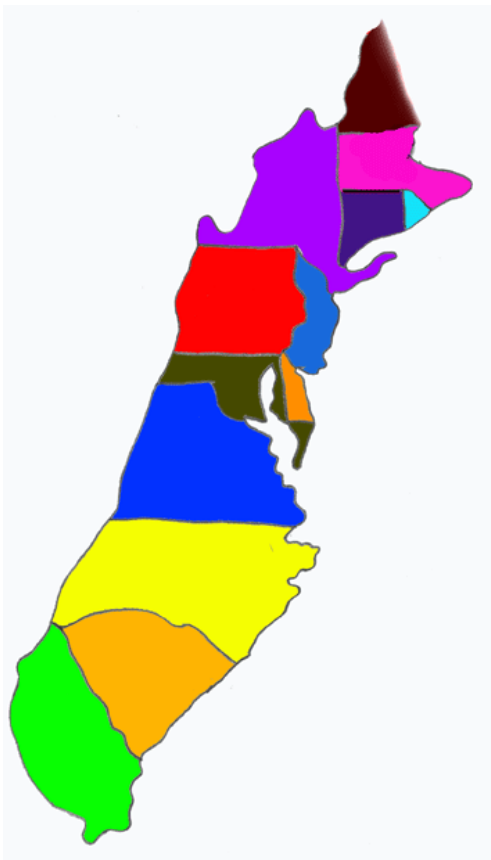
