2020 Summer School Registration Information

Purpose: Pearl City High School Summer School offers courses to meet the particular needs of students in areas such as acceleration, enrichment, review, and remediation. Summer School is financed entirely on tuition income.

It is strongly recommended that students **DO NOT** take courses for advancement due to the accelerated academic pace of summer school. Students may take courses to review for the upcoming school year. If summer school is used to repeat a class, the higher grade will replace a lower grade. **NOTE:** Summer school classes may be limited to 30 students.

Wait List: ALL students will be placed on a waitlist. When you are accepted into the class, we will email or call to confirm. Then you will come on the assigned day to pay for summer school. CASH ONLY PLEASE! **Please do not call the summer school office on your status. We will call and notify you.**

Attendance and Discipline Policy: See Pearl City High School Discipline and Attendance Guide (Attachment). **Please review with your child and the registration form (required for registration).**

Computer and Internet Access: Since summer school is all online, all courses will require students to have internet access and computers to attend classes and complete their assignments. The school library is closed during the summer.

Academic Information: Letter grades (A-F) will be used for student evaluation for all courses. The summer school grade will be recorded as part of the student's permanent transcript and included in the overall grade point average calculation. Credits are granted according to the number of hours enrolled.

Report Cards: Teachers will be emailing home the final grade, but an official report card will be mailed home. If you change your address after you register for summer school, it is your responsibility to notify the summer school office of the change.

Course Cancellation: Should enrollment not meet the required number to warrant the course or an additional section, the course or section may be cancelled and students given a full refund. The lack of a qualified teacher may also result in the cancellation of a course with full refund.

Course Offerings: Google Classroom and Google Hangouts will be used.

Instructions for Registration

1. Check with your counselor/teacher for course approval/selection. **It is the responsibility of the student/parent to ensure that they register for the correct course. Summer school will not verify your course selection.**
2. Complete online registration form to be put on a waitlist.
3. Summer school will contact you when you are accepted into the class, we will email or call to confirm. Then we will come on the assigned day to pay for summer school. CASH ONLY PLEASE! **Please do not call the summer school office on your status. We will call and notify you.**
4. If you are unable to register online, please call our office at 307-5605 to be placed on the waitlist. If you call to be on the waitlist, you are responsible to print out the registration form and submit with payment on the day you are assigned to come in.

First Day Information

1. You will be emailed by your teacher with your Google classroom information and a google meet time.
2. Please make sure you attend ALL google meet class times and on-time. Attendance will be taken and reported to the summer school office.
3. Students must be prepared for classes by bringing necessary materials and supplies (e.g. folder, folder paper, pen/pencil, etc). PE students should dress in t-shirts, shorts, and shoes for activities and have water available (not soft drink/juice).

PE Information

1. If you have a medical condition, it is not recommended that you take PE in the summer. Please consider taking the course during the school year.
2. If you have a medical condition, we will ask that you get a doctor's clearance note that says your child is cleared for participation. This note may be submitted via email to nikki.takai@k12.hi.us.
3. Parents and students must understand that the course is an activity focused course. There will be no one that is CPR and first-aid certified at the same physical location as the student.
4. Activity will run in 30-40 minute segments with 15 minute rest in between 3 sessions. Totalling approximately 1.5 hour each morning with cognitive concepts and projects after. Other active engagement will be self directed. Sessions are: dynamic warm up and cardio; flex and core; and health- related or skill-related fitness activity.
