

# Review of the Extended Day POW Process

•The FY11 Annual Report will be available on the teacher's menu March 15<sup>th</sup>.

- •Teachers already on extended day must complete the FY11 Annual Report to activate the FY12 POW.
- •Teachers not accumulating the points to meet each standard will be required to complete an Improvement Plan which must then be approved by the CTAE Director to activate the FY12 POW.



Extended Day POW Updates FY12

**Change in the Affiliation Standard:** 

- •The teacher must have an affiliated chapter to qualify for extended day. (except for CTI)
- •The required membership quantity requiring 60 members or 60% of class enrollment has been eliminated.



# POW Updates FY12 Annual Report

•Membership for the past three years will be reported on the Affiliation Standard so the local CTAE Director can check the trend when approving the POW.

- Chapter affiliation Reports will be posted on the gactso.org website.
- Point values have been adjusted for a better balance for similar events.

### Certification Issues: Culinary Endorsement

NW RESA is now an approved provider.
Approval for additional providers is in progress.

•Teachers who have already taken "previous coursework" will be allowed to complete the process through a GaDOE workshop and assessment process.



### Certification Issues: WBL Endorsement

•NW RESA is now an approved provider. Requiring the WBL endorsement for use of the State approved course numbers is no longer being pursued by GaDOE. •The WBL State Board Rule is in the process of being revised to outline the certification/training requirements of WBL coordinators.






