You will probably need to make this chart on two pages. The heading should say the following:

COMPARISON OF EARLY CORE FOUNDATIONAL CIVILIZATIONS

Make four columns on the first page and divide the page into three parts.

The first column should be for the Early Civilizations.
The second column should be for their Culture.
The third column should be for their Political
The fourth column should be just for their SOCIAL only.

Culture should combine any religious or intellectual things of importance from your SPRITE charts on the Period One Chapters (1-6). Culture will include, art, language, writing, intellectual achievements in areas such as math and science, philosophy, traditional values and religious beliefs.

Political should include the type of government, it's structure, laws, centralized vs. decentralized, any dynasties or great rulers.

Social should deal only with the social structure, how women/children were treated, social classes (merchants, priests, slaves, etc.)

On the second page follow the same directions.

The six core foundational societies that you should address are as follows:

Mesopotamia (Tigris & Euphrates Egypt (Nile River Valley) Indus River Valley (Harappan) Shang China (Huang He River Valley) MesoAmerica (Mexico & Central America) South America (Andean Region)
