

## 6TH GRADE FIELD TRIP INFORMATION

Dear Students and Parents:

We are extremely excited to present our plans for a special learning and team building opportunity being arranged for our 6th grade students this April 30 (Team R), May 1 (Team M) and May 2 (Team S). Our plan is to board chartered motor coaches for a packed day at Rock Eagle Park. Students will be able to bring a snack for morning or afternoon and a water bottle, so packing a small drawstring bag/Kavu is perfectly acceptable.

**We are planning to leave Riverwatch at 9:15 a.m. Please do not be late on that day. We are not able to wait for late students. Students will not be back to ride the bus home, so please make arrangements to pick up your child at 5:15pm.**

During our field trip, our students will participate in the following curriculum based learning activities:

*Native American Skills* -- Step back in time and encounter a variety of skills used by the Native Americans who inhabited Georgia. Activities will date back from 12, 000 to 500 years ago. Students will learn hands on skills that kept the early Native Americans alive.

*Lunch*-- Students will be served a Chef's Choice option in the cafeteria. The options that potentially could be available are pizza, burgers or chicken fingers. There will be a vegetarian option, probably a salad. Drinks will be available.

*Challenge Course* -- Groups focus on the principles of team-building by working through a progression of initiatives and elements. Each activity will focus on different aspect of the team. These aspects may include goal setting, trust, problem solving, planning or group cohesion. Most groups will progress on to the low ropes course during this class.

The cost of this learning opportunity is \$70, and it includes the following:
