2020-2021 School Year – 6th Grade Course Registration Information

Students and parents will be able to view their course recommendations online via Infinite Campus. The courses listed on that site will be used to generate student schedules for the 2020-2021 school year, unless changes are approved by PGMS Administrators. The student's final schedule will include all approved course change requests.
