

Pasco High School 2022-2023 Orientations FAQ

1. What/When is Freshmen/New Student Orientation?

a. Pasco High School will offer an in-person Freshmen/New Student orientation on Thursday, July 28, 2022, from 9 am – 1 pm. Students and parents should arrive between 8:45 and 9:00 am and report to the rear of the gym for an informational welcome session. Students will then remain on campus to participate in a series of mini sessions, tour our campus, and meet key staff members. Lunch will be provided to students! All students attending the orientation will receive their first piece of PHS spirit gear for free!

2. What/When is Registration/Open House Day for 10th - 12th Graders?

- a. PHS will be holding a virtual registration day for all 10th-12th grade students on Friday, August 5th, 2022. Schedules will be available for viewing and printing at this time via online. Families will also be able to pay school fees virtually at this time through the Parent Portal.
- b. While this event is virtual, campus will be open from 9 am 12 noon for students and parents wishing to walk schedules, meet teachers, or for those requiring technical assistance to set up a parent portal account, print a schedule, or pay school fees.

3. Is there an Orientation for 10th – 12th graders who are brand new to Pasco High School?

- a. Please join us on July 28, 2022 at 9am in the rear of the gym for an informational orientation designed to welcome you to Pasco High School. Please see informational flyer for additional information.

5. How will I be able to access my 2022-2023 class schedule?

a. Schedules will be available via myStudent on July 25th.

a. School fees are to be paid virtually through your parent portal account.

7. Will I be able to meet with a school counselor or administrator at Orientation?

a. All administrators and counselors will be actively facilitating our orientation and will not be available for individual meetings during those times – please contact your school counselor or administrator to set up an appointment during an available time.

a. Schedule change requests will be handled virtually through a schedule change request form that will become available on the school website. Schedules changes are not guaranteed, will be limited, and are processed on a first come, first served basis.
