Physical Geography of East Asia



- -Countries in the region: China, Japan, Mongolia, Taiwan, North Korea, and South Korea
- -Kunlun Mountains: located in Western China
- -The source of both the Yellow and Yangtze Rivers





Gobi Desert

- -Covers more than 5,000 miles from northwest China into Mongolia
- -Larger than Texas and California combined
- -During winter months, temperatures can drop to -40°F
- -During summer months, temperatures can reach 122°F





River Systems

- -Yellow River: originates in the Kunlun Mountains
- -Flows for more than 3,000 miles, empties into the Yellow Sea
- -The river has a yellowish tint because of the color of the soil it carries



River Systems

-Yangtze River: longest river in Asia (over 3,900 miles)

-Very important river for shipping and trading



Natural Resources

- -Because East Asia is such a mountainous region, land available for agriculture is limited
- -China's population is concentrated to the east where land is arable
- -The mountainous regions in western China are more sparsely populated

Natural Resources

- -Major natural resources of East Asia: petroleum, coal, natural gas, and iron ore
- -North and South Korea have plentiful gold and silver reserves
- -China's river systems provide crop irrigation, hydroelectric power, and transportation
