SENIOR PICK-UP/DROP-OFF

UPDATES

Graduation

Our Graduation service is now scheduled for **Monday**, **June 22 at 8:30 PM in Luella High School Lions Stadium.** In the letter from Dr. Davis on April 29 about senior activities and graduation, the following details were listed.

- Each graduate will be provided **4 tickets** for guests to attend the ceremony. This will be further evaluated as local and state restrictions either lessen or tighten.
- There will be a clear bag policy in effect with bags subject to search upon entry. Clear bags will not be provided.
- Stadiums will be staffed with health professionals along with hydration stations.
- Henry County Code of Conduct will be upheld for all on-campus activities.

We are now actively planning with all the other HCS high school principals to have a meaningful graduation service. I will have a more detailed plan for graduation soon.

Senior Activities

We are working together with the student senior leadership and senior sponsors to design any senior activities that can be accomplished given the appropriate health and safety guidelines.

Prom

During this week, we should have a new date for the re-scheduled Prom. As Dr. Davis stated in her letter, we will be issuing full refunds for those who paid for the originally-scheduled Prom. Students would then pay the new Prom fee, which should be less than the original fee. As is true with graduation planning, we are working with the other HCS high school principals to provide an appropriate opportunity that meets current health and safety guidelines.
